

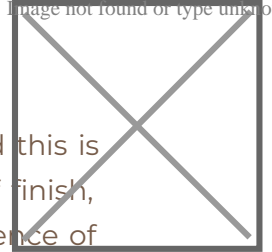

The large size of a sherrybutt implies a slowerpace for maturation ofwhisky, and this is especially true with 2nd fill wood: this is thereason why we waited 66months of finish, muchlonger than usual, untilwe judged this Speysidemalt to be ready. Theinfluence of Oloroso isobvious: not heavyhanded or thick, but verydry and nutty. The nose isfruity, winey, with apleasantly sour note. Redcherries, balsamicvinegar, a hint ofstrawberries. The spicyand winey character is unmistakably found at the palate, too: extremely dry, a bit tannic, peppery, with a sweeter touch of candied oranges and cereals. The compromise between sweet and sour can actually be altered with careful addition of water, and we left the choice to you: more water will makeit less spicy, but also less sweet, making it probably very suitable for an aperitif (maybe paired with some hard seasoned cheese). The finale is particularly spicy and peppery, with a lingering sour note.
